COMPETITOR FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for entering the Moonriver Night Race 2025 - we are looking forward to seeing you all on race day. Please read through the information below carefully to ensure the event runs smoothly and safely.

»» REGISTRATION ««

Registration will take place at The Old Dog, DE6 2AT, between 17:00 and 18:30. You must fill in a disclaimer form and will receive a race number, which must be worn on your front and be clearly visible at all times, and a wristband with a timing dibber.

The race will start and finish on Gag Lane, a 10 minute walk from registration (see the map below). Follow the small lane from the corner next to the garage until you pass through the first gate into Thorpe Pastures. Please leave plenty of time to reach the start, as we won't be waiting for latecomers!

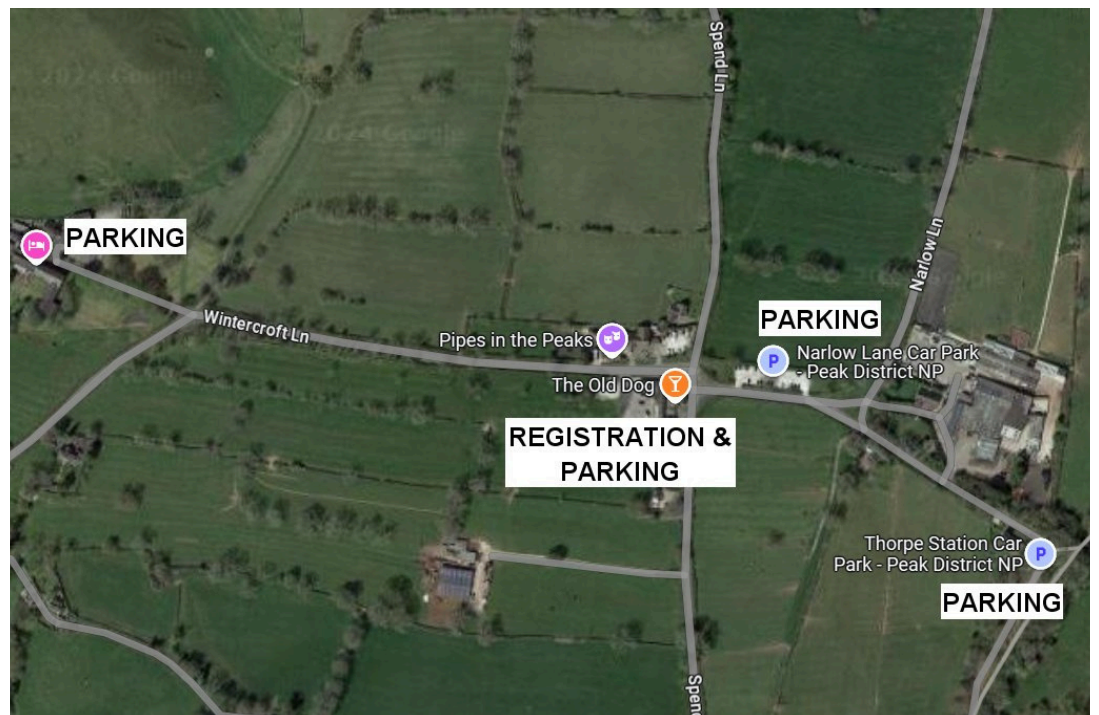
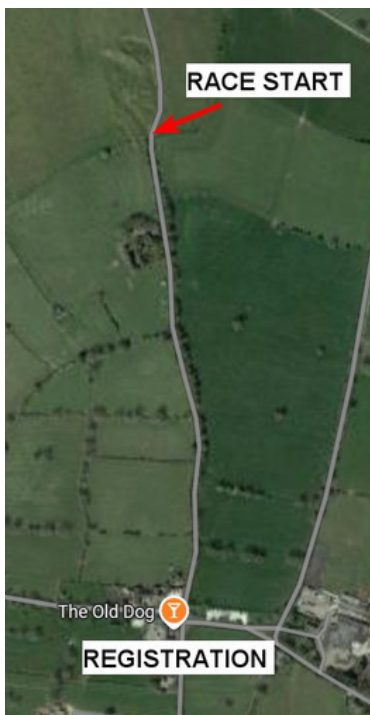
»» TRAVEL & PARKING ««

Car parking is available at the Old Dog pub, as well as at the nearby Narlows Lane and Thorpe Station car parks (pay and display, free after 6pm) (DE6 2AT) and Peveril of the Peak hotel (DE6 2AW) (see map below).

Please consider car-sharing where possible to reduce traffic and environmental impact.

»» TOILETS ««

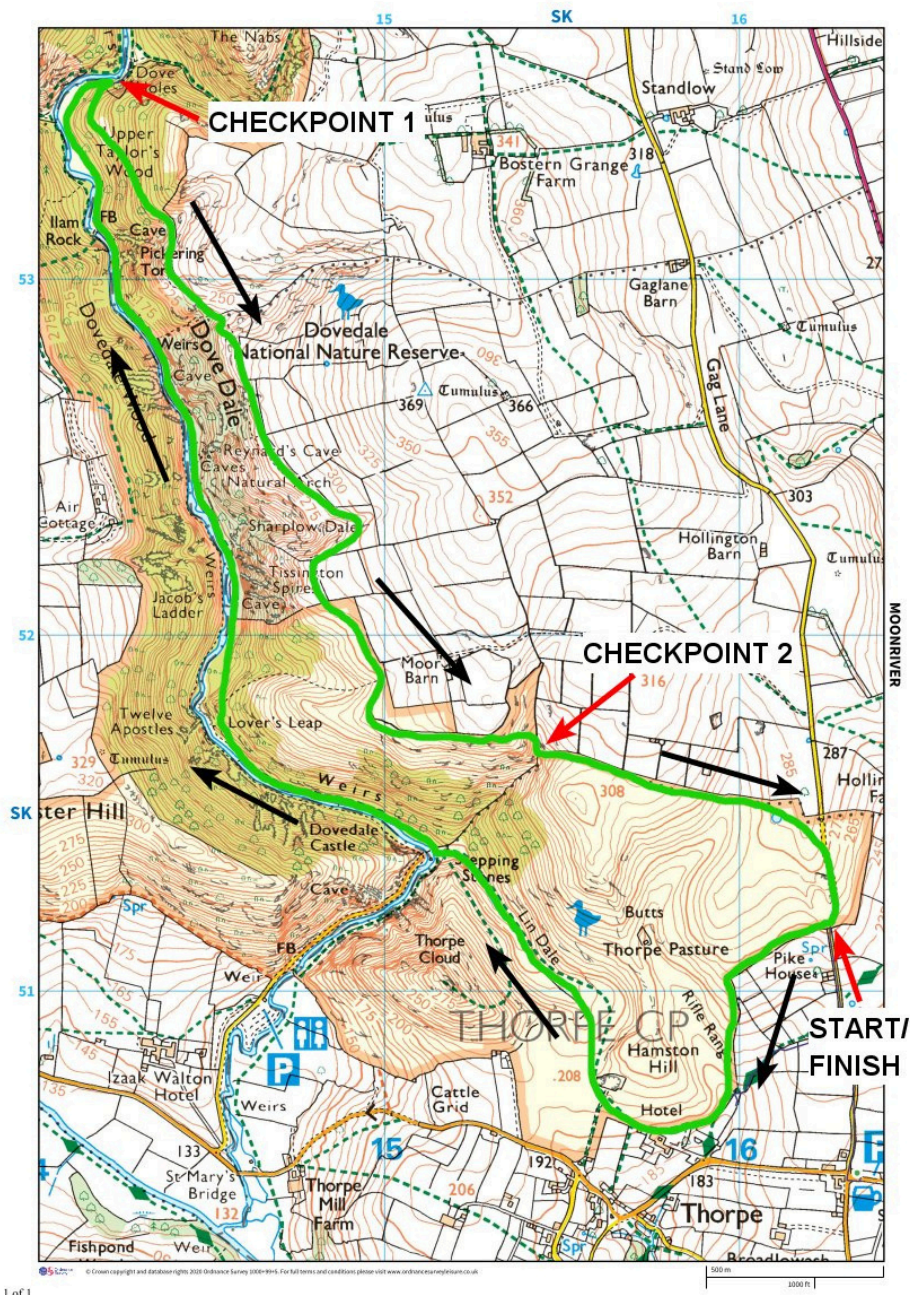
There are toilets situated at registration in the Old Dog.



»» COURSE INFORMATION ««

The course will be marked with reflective tape (with the exception of the path along the river - you can't go wrong!) and marshals will be situated along the route. There will be timing checkpoints situated at Dove Holes and at the stile into Thorpe Pastures (see map below) - you must insert your dibber at both checkpoints, as well as at the finish line checkpoint, to complete the race.

Failure to insert your dibber at either checkpoint or at the finish line will mean you do not receive a result.



Please take care as there are steep sections and some sections along the river of limestone steps/path and wooden boards which are very slippery.

Distance: 9.5 km | Elevation: 345 m | Category: BS

>>> KIT REQUIREMENTS <<<

All runners must carry full FRA kit (waterproof full-body cover, hat/buff, gloves, whistle, map, compass, emergency food) in addition to a (fully charged!) torch (head or body) and a mobile phone. It is also essential that you wear shoes with adequate grip (i.e. not road running shoes!).

>>> RETIREMENT <<<

If for any reason you decide not to complete the race, you **MUST** return to registration to report your retirement and return your dibber, even if you have already informed a marshal on the course. This is an essential safety requirement of the event and failure to do so could result in an unnecessary search by rescue organisations.

>>> REFRESHMENTS <<<

The Old Dog will be running a 25%-off deal on pies (steak or vegan cassoulet bean) after the race. They are opening the pub especially for us, so if you would like food, please pre-order by clicking [HERE](#).

>>> RESULTS <<<

After finishing, please return to registration to download your result and return your dibber. Dibbers **MUST** be handed in to the organising team **ON THE DAY** - there will be a charge of £30 for any lost/missing dibbers.

>>> PRIZES <<<

Prizegiving will take place at the Old Dog once all of the age-category winners have finished. Inov-8 have kindly provided prizes for this year's race. Prizes will be awarded to the first three men and women and to the winner of each age category (MU23, WU23, M40, W40, M50, W50, M60, W60, M70, W70), limited to one prize per competitor. There will also be men and women's team prizes (3 runners per team), as well as some spot prizes.
