
Getting to the event

By car

Please carshare if at all possible. Parking at the event is not plentiful, and the area is also popular with the general public.

There are two car parks for the event.

- 1. East Plean Primary School, Main St, Plean FK7 8BX, NS835870, ///inefficient.crackled.mascots, c.1.5km from Assembly. Please use this car park if you can, to reduce pressure on the nearer car park. There will be a taped route to Assembly.
- 2. Plean Country Park, Cadgers Loan, Plean FK7 8BB, NS827868, ///fattening.cakewalk.trade. Adjacent to Assembly. However, please note that this car park cannot accommodate all of our parking needs. Moreover, we do not have exclusive use of the car park, and need to keep some space for the general public. Priority will be given to cars with young children, anyone else who might struggle with the walk from Plean, and full cars. Anyone else: please walk up from the village if at all possible.



Marshals will be on site at both car parks. If both car parks are full, please park considerately on-street in Plean village. Do not attempt to park on the single-track road immediately outside the country park.

By public transport

The 38 Stirling-Falkirk bus runs every 30 minutes. Travel time:

- 18 minutes from Stirling station
- 15 minutes from Camelon station
- 20 minutes from Falkirk Grahamston station.

Details at https://www.mcgillsscotlandeast.co.uk/services/MBLB/38. It is a 1km walk from the bus stop to Assembly.

Assembly and download: Adjacent to car park 2, near the entrance to the park.

Toilets: Toilet facilities are available adjacent to the car park. Please be considerate: no muddy shoes, please!

Start

300m from Assembly/download.

Start times 11:00-13:00. Punching start.

Call up four minutes before your start time. Loose control descriptions available in the start lane.

NB the **British Night Championships prizegiving** will take place at **10:30** at Assembly. We hope that this will be completed before the first starts.

100m from Assembly/download. Punching finish, and please don't forget to download!

Courses close 14:30.

Terrain

Mixed woodland and parkland, with a complex path network. The south of the area is a reclaimed "bing", or spoil heap, a reminder of the area's coalmining past.

There has been some damage to the park from Storm Éowyn. Our assessment is that the event can go ahead as planned, but there will be some unmapped fallen trees.

Some fallen trees may cross paths, including on the White and Yellow courses, but it is straightforward to walk round them.

Safety

Plean is popular with dog walkers and horse riders, so please be courteous to other users.

The organiser will review the weather forecast on the day and advise competitors if special precautions are required. Waterproof jackets may be compulsory. The event will be cancelled if dangerous weather is forecast or occurs.

Map and control descriptions

Survey and cartography by Chris Smithard 2020; updated 2023, 2025. 1:7500, 5m contours. The Yellow and White courses have textual control descriptions; all other courses have pictorial control descriptions.

In the control descriptions, the symbol \times ("Prominent feature / Special item") is used exclusively for platforms. These are mapped using a small brown triangle: \triangle
